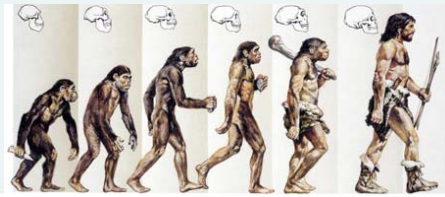

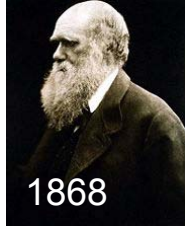

## **200 Jahre Charles Darwin: 1809, 1859, ..., 2009**

This year, the ether is filled with „Charles Darwin“, for well-known reasons. Yet remarkably, public opinion polls have revealed a blatant ignorance among people when it comes to Darwin's ideas and evolution, even among biology students.

In the first part of this talk, I will try to provide some information about the little-known Darwin, on his life between 1836 (after the return from voyage on the Beagle) and 1882 (the year of his death).

In the second part, emphasis will be laid on some very recent findings on beak evolution and development in Darwin's finches and on earth worm grunting and foraging moles, upon Darwin researched in his latest years.
