We have over 20 slots available for 15 minutes talks (+ 5 minutes discussion) and an unlimited capacity for poster presentations.


If you would like to participate at the meeting, please send us an email (dzg25th@gmail.com) no later than the 1.5.2020 with the following information:

Lunch

You can have lunch in the canteen at the university (mensa). They also have vegetarian dishes and a salad bar. Typically you need to 5-6 Euros (without drinks).

There are also 2 restaurants very close to university that are open during lunch time:

- Tokyo house (one of our favorites) is only 5 minutes walk from university gate. It has South Asian food (mix of Japanese and Chinese food). Note that they are not open for lunch on Monday
- Fengshui is right across Tokyo house and specialized on Chinese food. Note that they are closed on Tuesdays.
