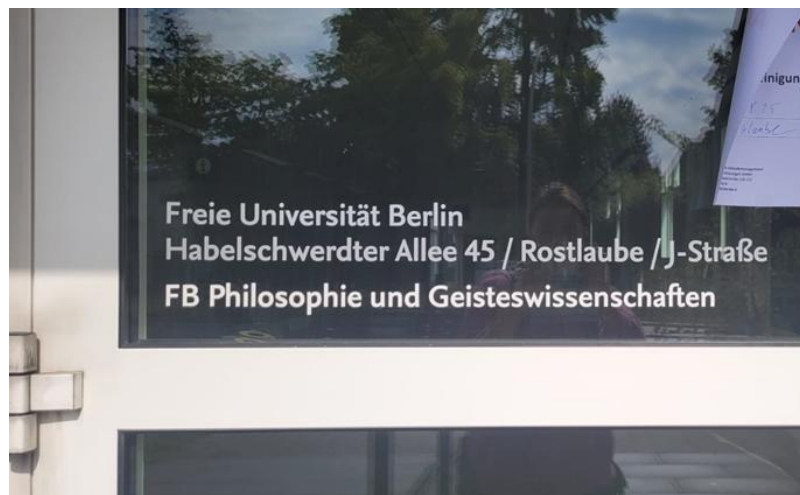

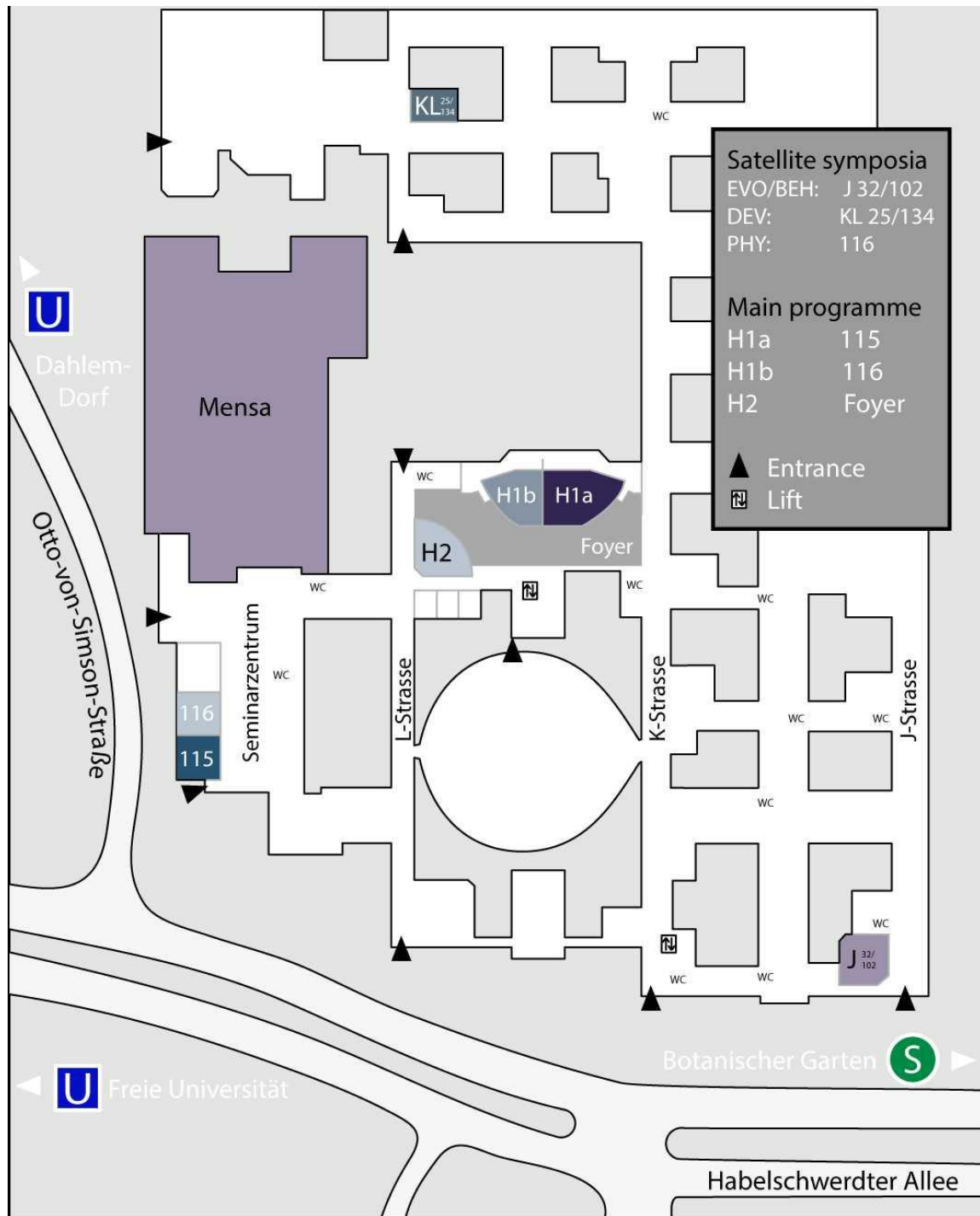
### Instructions:
