#### Instructions:


- Please check the weather forecast and bring appropriate clothing, as we will spend part of the day outdoors in the Botanical Garden.

- A laptop will be useful for the data session but not necessary. You may leave your bags and laptops securely in the seminar room during the fieldwork.


## Meals (self-paid):
